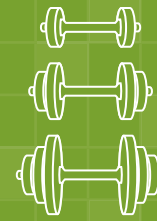

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Our facilities accept cash, check, MasterCard or Visa. Annual Memberships can also be purchased through a monthly electronic bank transfer. Financial assistance is available for qualifying Denver residents. DPS students who attend a qualifying school can receive a free annual membership and a discount of at least 50 percent off registration for sports and classes. REGIONAL LEVEL

Our regional level centers are open 7 days a week and most holidays. Membership includes access to all 27 centers and all fitness classes at any center.

LOCAL LEVEL

Our local level centers are open 5-6 days a week. Membership includes access to 20 local and neighborhood centers and all classes at those centers. Members can also access regional centers for a small fee.

NEIGHBORHOOD LEVEL

Our neighborhood level centers are open 5-6 days a week. Membership includes access to nine neighborhood centers as well as classes at those centers. Members can also access local and regional facilities for a small fee.
