

Insulation Rebates for Denver Homeowners

Properly insulating and sealing a home can help reduce monthly energy bills and make your home more comfortable.

Smart Energy Living Alliance has partnered with Greenprint Denver and the Governor's Energy Office's 2008 Insulate Colorado program to offer cash-back rebates to qualifying homeowners in the City and County of Denver.

The rebates will be issued for the installation of either attic or exterior wall insulation and basic air sealing measures, performed by an approved contractor (do-it-yourself projects are not eligible).

The rebates cover 20 percent of the total cost of insulation and air sealing upgrades or \$300, whichever is less. Rebates will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis until program funding is exhausted. This is a limited time offer. Rebates are not guaranteed.

Participation Is as Easy as 1-2-3

1. Complete an Insulate Colorado Homeowner Rebate Request Form http://www.greenprintdenver.org/docs/Insulation_Rebate_Denver.pdf
2. Attach a copy of the contractor's invoice showing total job costs and measures installed.
3. Include a copy of the official Insulation Card demonstrating the amount of insulation added.
