NOTICE OF LODGING OF PROPOSED CONSENT DECREES

The State of Colorado, through the Trustees for Natural Resources Damages, has filed a Complaint, pursuant to section 107(f) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act, 42 U.S.C. § 9607(f), more commonly known as CERCLA, for

damages in connection with the release or threat of release of hazardous substances from Lowry Landfill, known as the Lowry Landfill Superfund Site (“Site”).

By way of this Notice, the Trustees notify the Court that the State of Colorado has lodged proposed Consent Decrees in this matter (the “Decrees”). The Decrees, which are included with this notice and titled, “Consent Decree For Generator Defendants — Colorado Natural Resources Related to Lowry Landfill” and “Performing Parties Consent Decree — Colorado Natural Resources Related to Lowry Landfill,” would resolve the Trustees’ claims against Defendants for natural resources damages relating to the Site. The ultimate entry of the Decrees would end this litigation.

The Court should not sign the Decrees at this time. Instead, the Decrees should remain lodged with the Court while the Trustees provide an opportunity for public comment.
