

Jeffrey Hart, CGFM, CFE, has served in positions of increasing responsibility at the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Office of Inspector General (OIG) since he was appointed Manager of the Denver, Colorado office in 1991. He is currently responsible for OIG evaluations and performance audits nationwide concerning global climate change as well as EPA's stewardship, voluntary, and partnership programs.
