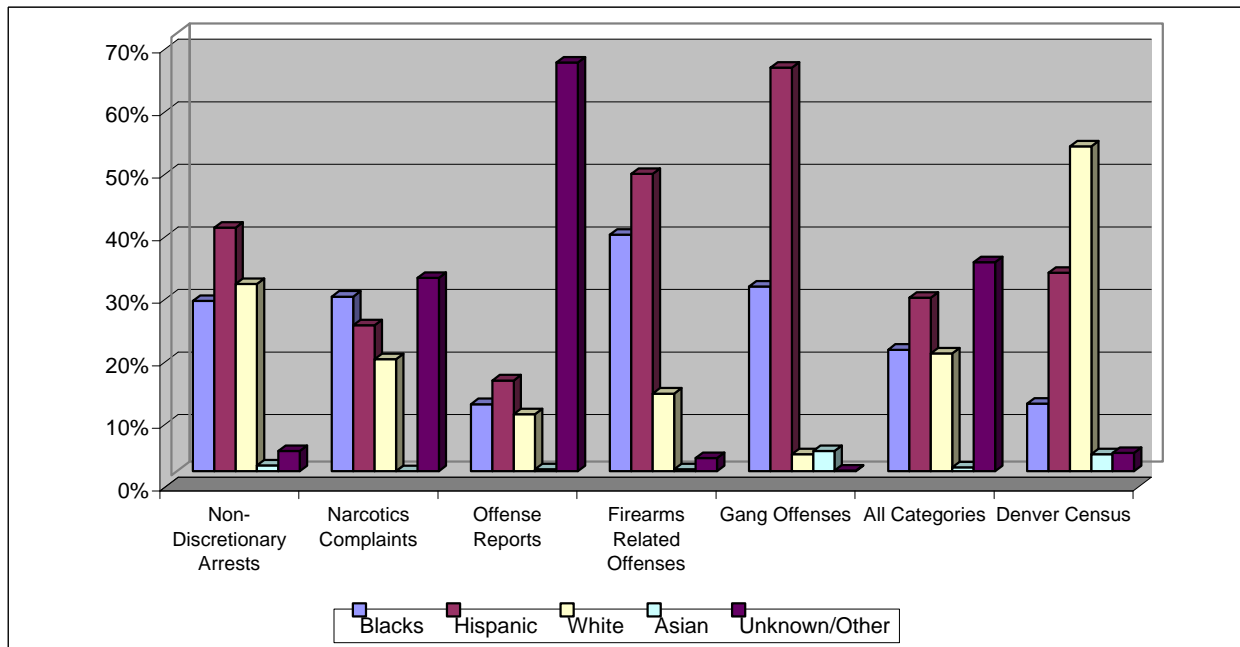

**\* Categories of crime activity are described as:**

- Non-Discretionary Arrests - arrests where the officer has little or no choice as to who is arrested based on a victim's complaint (see page two for listing of included offenses)
- Narcotic Complaints - complaints of narcotic activity phoned into the Drug Hotline
- Offense Reports - victim reporting of crimes, does not include officer self-generated reports such as drug offenses or resisting arrest (see page four for listing of included offenses)
- Firearms Related Offenses - reported crimes in which the suspect was armed with a firearm
- Gang Offenses - reported crimes that were gang motivated
- All Categories - combination of the five categories listed above
- Denver Census - Denver's population as reported in the 2000 Census
