Notice of Construction Activities

In late March and early April, our contractor Rocksol will be drilling borings along Alameda Avenue and Cherry Creek South Drive. This work is to determine subsurface geology and locate utilities to prepare for additional design and construction.

Beginning mid-May 2009, our contractor Brannan Sand and Gravel Co will be working on Holly Street from Evans Ave to Cherry Creek South Blvd as it undergoes a Pavement Reconstruction Project through September.

Alameda and Cherry Creek

Since the adoption of the *Cherry Creek Corridor Greenway Master Plan* in 2000, construction of the first phases from University Blvd. to Steele St. and at the intersection of Colorado Blvd. has been completed. Funding has now been designated to reconstruct Alameda from University Blvd. to Cherry Creek South Dr. and to complete final design of the Cherry Creek South Drive from Alameda to Colorado Blvd.

The addition of the Alameda reconstruction will provide pedestrian improvements including improved crosswalks, and curb ramps, as well as a new traffic signal at the intersection with Cherry Creek South Dr. and an improved roadway surface.

At this time, the next phase of design for Cherry Creek South Dr. consists of providing sidewalks, a recreational loop trail, landscaping improvements, off-street parking, improvements to Harrison Street, and berming to enhance the environment within the park.

Holly Street

The asphalt surface on Holly St. will be replaced with concrete from Evans Ave to Florida Ave, and with new asphalt pavement from Florida Ave to Cherry Creek South Dr. Drainage improvements will be made between Evans Ave and Atlantic Place. Concrete sidewalk and corner ramp repair will be made in select locations.

Normal work hours will be from 7:00 AM – 5:00 PM Monday-Friday. Additional and/ or weekend hours may be required to complete certain tasks. Current project phasing intends on completing work along the frontage of school facilities prior to the end of summer break.

Two-way traffic will generally be permitted at all times from Evans Ave to Florida Ave during construction. From Florida Ave to Cherry Creek South Blvd, the project will be completed in stages, and only one lane of traffic in one direction will be permitted. As a result, travel in one direction will be closed and detours for local traffic will be in place.
