Septic-to-Sanitary Entrance Requirements

Authority:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✚ Revised Municipal Code, Chapter 56, Section 102 (d & f) “Disposal of Wastes and Use of Public Sewers” ✚ Public Works Rules & Regulations Governing Sewerage Charges & Fees & Management of Wastewater.
Purpose of Ordinance:	The purpose of this document is to summarize the key issues related to the issuance of a Sewer Use and Drainage Permit for a structure to go from a septic tank connection to sanitary sewer mainline connection.
Document Date:	October 9, 2008
Permit Types:	Sewer Use and Drainage Permit (Septic-to-Sanitary)
Application & Permit Dates:	The permit will expire one (1) year from date of issuance if work has not commenced, or, if after partial completion the work is discontinued for one year, the permit shall become void.
Customer Interface:	<i>Most</i> communications between the City and the customer will be done through Public Works Permit Operations (PWPO) 303-446-3759. The customer may also have cause to speak with Public Works Engineers and Inspectors.

Considerations:	<p>General Guidelines for Sewer Use and Drainage Permits for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✚ Site Plan <p>All sewer work must be done by a licensed City Plumbing or Sewer Contractor.</p>
Approval Process:	A Sewer Use & Drainage Permit from septic tank to sanitary connection requires a full review at the Public Works Permit Operations office.
Fees:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✚ Application fee of \$100.00 is due at the time of submittal. ✚ The fees for new sanitary sewer connections are detailed in the Sewer Tap Fees located at www.denvergov.org/des ✚ All checks should be made payable to Manager of Finance.
