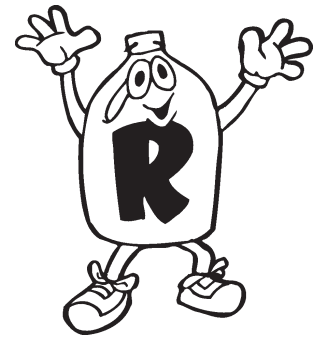
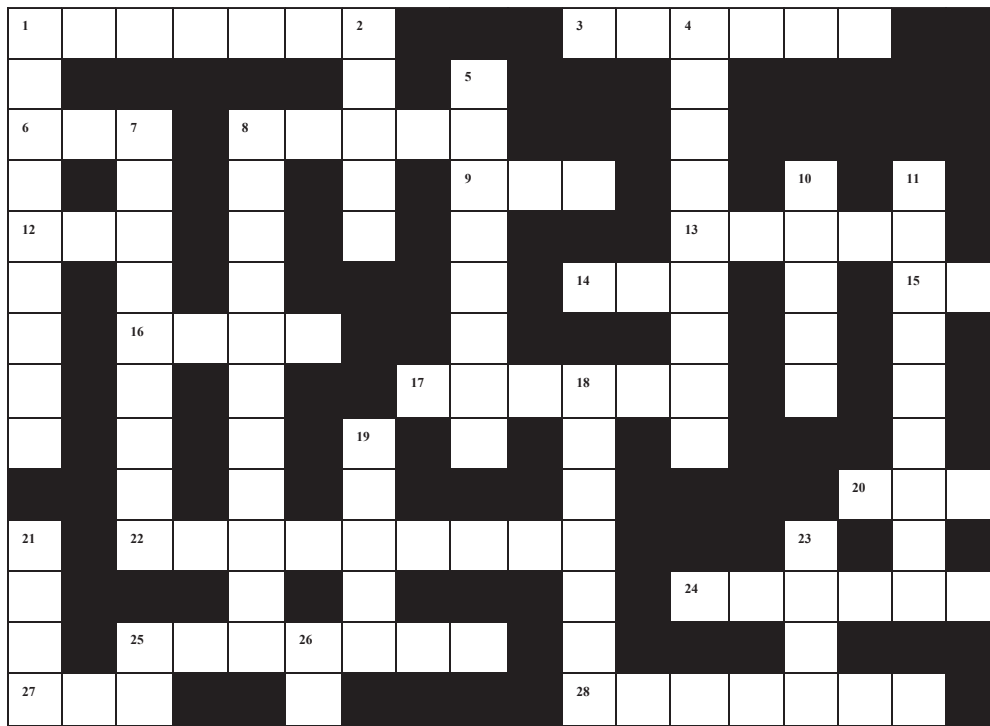


MARV'S RECYCLING CROSSWORD PUZZLE
