Legislative Information System

Description: Denver City Council requires an automated system to provide electronic management of legislative documents that come before the Council, workflow management, and electronic voting and record keeping. This project provides a Commercial off the Shelf (COTS) solution, which will provide legislative information for all Council members in electronic format, assist in the preparation and routing of legislative documents, and enable electronic voting and record keeping. The LIS will also interface to the CCTV system which televises all Council sessions.

Benefits & Opportunities: Reduces the paperwork load on the City Council by providing legislation in an electronic format and provides an easier and more effective means for council members to vote on the legislation before them. LIS provides a permanent record in digital format of all Council actions in regards to legislation which comes before the City Council.
