- **4-H Entrepreneur Programs (NFTE)**

Many youth express a desire to "one day, own their own business." Research indicates, however, that most new businesses fail after the first year. Youth between 14-18 have the opportunity to learn through a 14-week interactive on-line program utilizing the National Foundation For Teaching Entrepreneurism curriculum.
