Gardening Services (May through September)

- **Plant Sample Diagnosis:** Denver residents may bring in plant samples for diagnosis to the Colorado State University Denver Extension office (888 E. Iliff Avenue in Harvard Gulch Park) between 8 am and 5 pm Monday through Friday. Turn-around time on information is usually four days. (The office will be closed on Labor Day.) Residents may also call and leave a message on the Master Gardener call-in line at 720-913-5278.
- **Cherry Creek Farmers Market:** The Colorado Master Gardeners staff a booth at the Cherry Creek Farmers Market (1st Avenue and University Boulevard) to answer gardening questions and review plant samples on Wednesdays from 8:30 am to 1 pm and Saturdays from 7:30 am to 1 pm.
- Every Tuesday and Saturday Colorado Master Gardeners are also available, to answer gardening questions and review plant samples, from 12 noon to 4 pm in the **Denver Botanic Gardens Library***. Master Gardeners may also be **reached by phone** at 720-865-3575 on Tuesday and Saturday (noon-4 pm) to answer questions by phone.

*NOTE: There is an admittance fee into the Denver Botanic Gardens for non-members.

- **Lawn Check:** A CSU Denver Extension lawn expert is available to provide on-site residential lawn assessment. The cost for this service is \$75.
