CHEESMAN PARK TRAFFIC CALMING AND IRRIGATION IMPROVEMENTS

Park Improvement Projects – Scheduled for October 2009 – Spring 2010

Beginning in Fall of 2009, construction projects to upgrade the park irrigation system and pedestrian trails will be undertaken. This work will be phased and will result in a fully renovated irrigation system and upgrades to the pedestrian system in the park.

The first phase of the work will include the installation of 7 raised pedestrian crossing tables, 1 speed hump and additional stop signs and crosswalks. The intent of these improvements is to increase pedestrian safety and slow automobile traffic.

The second phase of the work includes the installation of a new irrigation tap and new irrigation mainline through the meadow (middle) area of the park. Portions of the meadow will be closed to public use during this construction. Closely following that work will be the renovation of the entire meadow (middle) area irrigation system. The entire meadow (middle) area will be closed to the public during this phase of the work.
