Bird Walks and Habitat Talks

Walks are designed to visit different types of bird habitat throughout Denver.

January 21st, 9 am

Red Rocks, Denver Mountain Park

I 70 west, exit 259, left 1.5 miles to park entrance. Follow road up to the Trading Post parking lot.

February 11th, 9 am

Overland Pond Park

South on S. Platte River Dr, east on Florida, parking lot on left. We will enjoy the pond and river in the winter!

March 24th, 9 am

Bear Creek Park + Bear Valley

East on Dartmouth from Sheridan Blvd, south on S. Raleigh under 285 to first parking lot by the river. Will end walk west on Dartmouth at Harlan to view beaver dam area.

April 21st, 9 am

Westerly Creek Natural Area

Meet at Sand creek trailhead west on Smith road off Havana to dirt lot at approx Dayton St. This is where Sand creek meets Westerly and where wading birds visit.

May 19th, 9 am

Red Rocks, Denver Mountain Park

I - 70 west, exit 259, left 1.5 miles to park entrance. Follow road up to the Trading Post parking lot.

May 26, 9 am

City Park Colorado Blvd and 17th, behind the Zoo and DMNS. Meet at the large playground. Come learn about birds on Duck island and around the park!
