Cook Park + Cherry Creek

7100 Cherry Creek Dr S, meet in Rec center parking lot. Great area to view beaver and wetland activity

July 14th, 9 am

Genesee Mountain Park

20 miles west of Denver on 1-70, south off exit 254. Meet at main park lot.

August 18th, 9 am

Eisenhower Park + Wellshire Golf.

4300 E Dartmouth Ave, meet in Rec. center parking lot. We will include walk on highline trail to golf course to see waterfowl and raptor habitat.

September 22nd, 9 am

Sloan's Lake, Sheridan Blvd and 26th.

Meet at Lake house (off Tennyson/26th)
Walk around the lake to see variety of birds.

October 20th 9 am

Parkfield Park, 15555 E 53rd Ave

Chambers Rd N of 1-70 right on 54th, meet in front of Rec center off park lot. View birds on lake and surrounding natural area.

November 17th, 9 am

Huston Lake Park 2700 W. Ohio Ave

Meet at southeast corner of park behind the lake. Great late season migration viewing!

December 8th, 9 am

Washington Park, S. Downing St and Kentucky Ave, meet at parking lot by the boat rentals. Join us for final walk to view waterfowl and winter visitors.
