Better Denver-Funded Renovations Complete at Green Valley Ranch East Park

What: An official ribbon cutting ceremony for Green Valley Ranch East Park. The park has undergone an extensive renovation, including a new picnic shelter with grills, basketball courts, ball field, sand volleyball court, off-leash dog park, parking lot and a new irrigation system.

The City of Denver's \$550 million voter-approved Better Denver Bond Program is working to preserve, renovate and create amenities that touch citizen's lives – including roads, libraries, parks, recreation centers, child care sites, hospitals, public safety, City buildings and cultural facilities.
