Upon appeal, an AHO may reduce the first offense fines up to twenty-five percent (25%) upon a finding of mitigation of circumstances in favor of the Responsible Party.

For a second offense within one year, the \$100 fines listed above shall be \$250.00 and the \$150 fines listed above shall be \$500.00. Upon appeal, an AHO may reduce the second offense fines up to twenty-five percent (25%) upon a finding of mitigation of circumstances in favor of the Responsible Party.

For a third offense within one year, the \$100 fines listed above shall be \$500.00 and the \$150 fines listed above shall be \$999.00. Upon appeal, an AHO may reduce the third offense fines up to twenty-five percent (25%) upon a finding of mitigation of circumstances in favor of the Responsible Party.

A finding of mitigation of circumstances shall occur only upon a determination by the AHO in the AEO that the Responsible Party has violated some provision in Article I of Chapter 39, DRMC, but that there are special circumstances or factual considerations that mitigate the violation by the Responsible Party so as to warrant the reduction of the fine imposed under this Attachment B. The finding of mitigation must be expressly stated in the AEO when the fine is reduced as allowed under this Attachment B.
