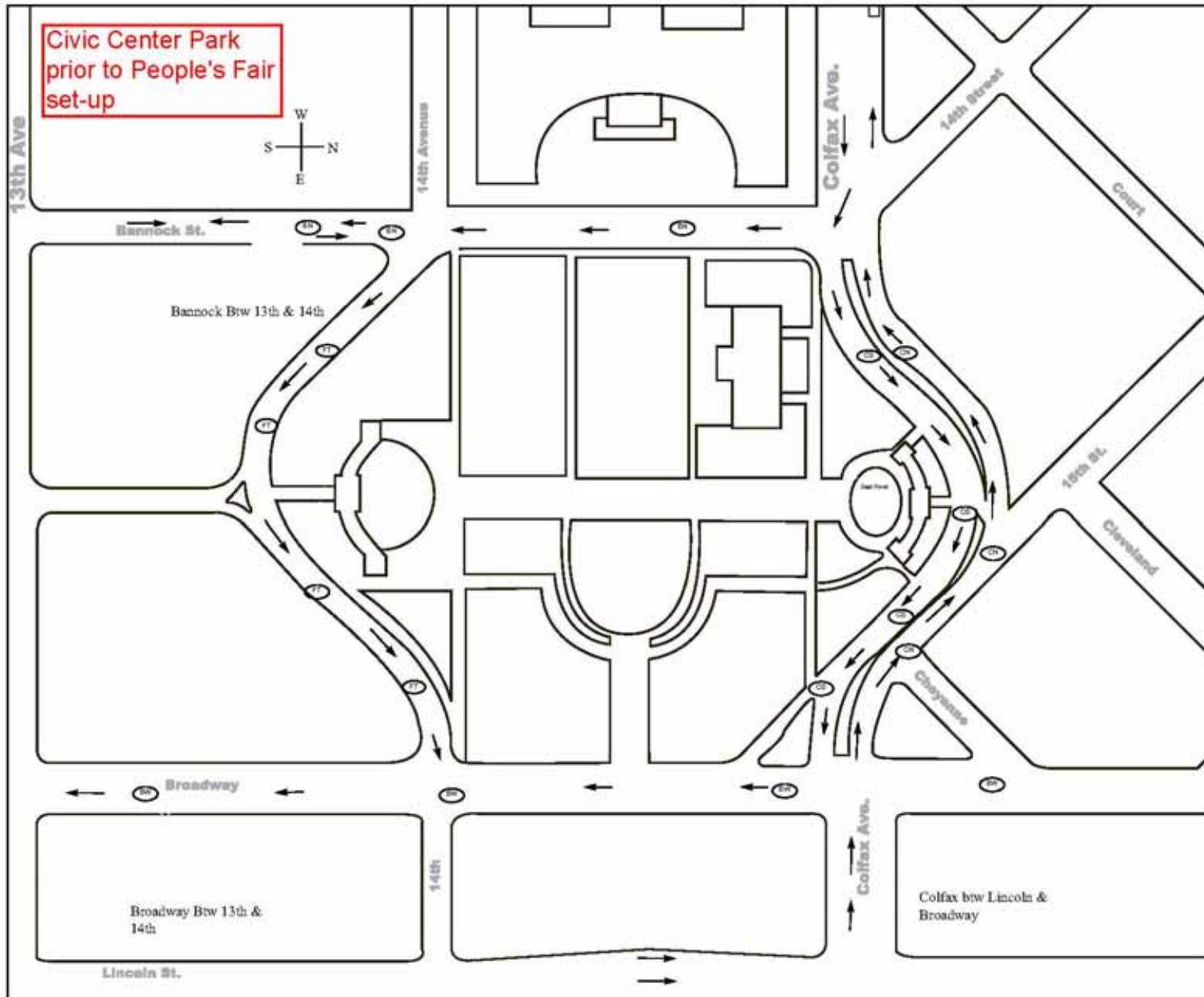

City of Denver – Parks and Recreation Collaboration

- Civic Center Park Permit
 - Review of entire site plan
 - Submission / Review of vendors, contracts and permits
 - Waste management – trash, dumpsters, porto's
 - Security - police, contract security
 - Perimeter fencing
 - Licensing and permitting, liquor, street closures, etc.
 - Food & Merchant Vendor lists
- Acquisition of Recycle Bins – Several hundred
- Coordination of supplemental electrical needs
- Pre event walk through
- Post event walk through

Other City Department Collaboration

- State of Colorado – Lincoln Park Permit
- City of Denver Excise and License (and State of Colorado) – Liquor license and Cabaret permit
- Department of Public Works – Street Closures, Traffic Plans and Meter Bagging
