Budget/Carry Over Funds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On target to spend \$3 million in 2008. Have spent approximately \$1.2 million to date. 	
Committee Reports	<p>Systems Performance:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Committee decided to support Chrysalis initiative in their last meeting. <p>Jail Services:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Classes are opening, July 24th is the ribbon cutting/open house. Continuing to work on programming to be included in new building – Inmate Council involved. <p>Reentry:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grand opening on July 14th. Approximately 400-500 people attending. Thirty providers. Received \$1400 from Denver Foundation, \$2k from the City and about \$3k in in-kind and monetary donations overall. Next discussion to take place will be the relationship between the city and the project. <p>Youth:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Had first meeting looking at courtroom 191J. Will be bringing the Systems Performance committee into this discussion to talk about impact on system. Staff-secure beds – not a dead issue at this point. Still having some trouble with Omni (evaluation/research) accessing data at the state level. <p>Mental Health:</p>	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All going well – working on problem solving new initiatives at monthly meeting- particularly Court to Community. 	
General updates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Judge Marcucci reported on the Chrysalis program and the difference it has made in the lives of the women he has worked with. Commission needs to make a formal decision to support this initiative in two ways: in theory and with potential dollars if funding is not granted through the City (to Vince’s office- City Attorney) and Judge Armatas needs to come back with a funding request. Charles Garcia moves to support, all in favor. • Draft report to Mayor of all Commission initiatives is presented to the Commission. • Gang proposal for funding for strategic planning was presented. Some concerns from the Commission: how and what will other cities contribute? There is not enough information to vote. It doesn’t appear that there is enough data to support that this particular strategy works. Did this proposal go through one of the committees? Yes – Youth/Prevention. Jeaneene makes motion made to postpone decision until next Commission meeting. More information needed. All in favor excluding Jeremy. • General concerns about proposal: what is an appropriate proposal to bring to the Commission for decision? What is the process? What have we committed funds to for 2008? This proposal needs to be weighed in with other proposals that are out there before such a big commitment is made. Who supervises the funds? Does Commission run programs? • Graffiti – needs a place to be situated. Suggestion is within the Commission – will not require dollars, just the Executive Director’s time. Fellow will come on to handle carrying out recommendations. Some feel this still needs conversation – what is the nexus between graffiti, crime control and prevention. Cheryl motions to have graffiti come under the Commission. All in favor excluding Lisa. • Hiring a second Program Coordinator – will need help with interviewing – Phil, Cheryl, Armatas, Linkhart volunteer to interview. • September retreat planned. • Need members to look at how to spend carryover funds – Lisa and Richard nominated to do this. • Judge Armatas raised that if members don’t come for a certain number of meetings, they should be off the Commission. People need to be committed and part of the 	

	decision-making process. There are currently a couple of vacant seats.
