Resolution in Support of Arizona Federal District Court and Arizona Citizens

WHEREAS, The Denver Latino Commission (“DLC”) is committed to promoting social justice and equality in the Latino/a community;

WHEREAS, Judge Bolton of the Arizona Federal District Court recently rendered an order enjoining the most egregious sections of Arizona’s SB 1070 law;

WHEREAS, Many of the citizens of Arizona have made the ultimate sacrifice in recent days by being incarcerated for opposing SB 1070 and the authorities who zealously seek to enforce its provisions;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the DLC honors Judge Bolton and the citizens of Arizona who have sacrificed their liberty to oppose SB 1070, to stand up to intolerance, and to promote a commitment to inclusion and equity.

The Commissioners of the Denver Latino Commission have approved this letter in their capacity as Commissioners, and not in their respective employment positions.
