

Sample Ballot

for the General Municipal Election, May 4, 1999

City and County of Denver, Colorado.

For this election the citizens of Denver will be voting for Mayor, Auditor, 2 Election Commissioners, 2 Councilmembers-at-large, a Councilmember to represent each of 11 Council Districts, and 4 Charter Amendments. Because there are 11 Council Districts, there are 11 ballot styles.

Each voter can vote for one candidate for Mayor, one candidate for Auditor and one candidate to represent the voter's Council District. The voter can vote for 2 candidates for Election Commissioner and 2 for Councilmembers-at-large. The voter may choose to write in the name of a person who is not listed on the ballot. There is either 1 or 2 write-in spaces for each office to be filled. The number of write-in spaces is determined by the number of candidates the voter can vote for in any particular contest.

Election day voting is from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. Most polling places are accessible; call to make sure yours is. If it is not accessible, you can be reassigned to a neighboring precinct that is accessible. A change to a new polling place must be made more than 12 days before an election.
