I. DEPARTMENTAL MATTERS IN THE REGULAR COURSE OF BUSINESS:

A. Parks and Recreation – Chantal Unfug

A-1. Parks and Recreation fee changes.

B. Office of Telecommunication – Darryn Zuehlke

B-1. *Approves a contract extension to the agreement with Denver Open Media (DOM), the public access TV station, through December 31, 2012. This brings the DOM contract into the same timeline as the Comcast cable franchise agreement.

C. Career Service Authority – Bruce Backer

C-1. *Amends the following classification titles and pay as follows: change title of Psychologist Team Leader (814-O) to Psychologist Supervisor (815-O); Operations and Production Supervisor (808-T) to Entertainment Production Coordinator (808-G); and Deputy Manager of Aviation for Operations pay grade from 818-A to 819-A.

D. Office of Economic Development – Seneca Holmes

D-1. *Corrects Ordinance # 518 to add funding in the amount of \$200,000 from the Employment Support Fund allocation from the Wagner-Peyser Adjustment #1 as part of the Workforce Investment Act PY09/FY10.

E. Human Services – Nan Morehead

E-1. *Authorizes a 12-month extension through September 30, 2010 and adds \$118,967 to the Regents of the University of Colorado contract to provide comprehensive intervention and enhanced treatment services to substance exposed infants and children as required by the Colorado System Integration Model for Infants grant.

E-2. *Authorizes a 12-month extension through September 30, 2010 and adds \$196,861 to an agreement with the University of Colorado, Addiction Research and Treatment Services to provide substance abuse treatment services related to the Denver Entire Family Focused Comprehensive Treatment (EFFECT) grant.

E-3. *Authorizes a 12-month extension through September 30, 2010 and adds \$323,526 in federal funding to an agreement with the Regents of the University of Colorado to provide Child Parent Psychotherapy (CPP) to abused and neglected children.

E-4. *Authorizes an increase in the amount of \$322,186 to an agreement with Arapahoe House, Inc. to provide services related to the Denver Entire Family Focused Comprehensive Treatment (EFFECT) grant.

F. Public Works – Christine Downs

F-1. *Ratifies existing permits for work on Stapleton and grants authority to Manger of Public Works and Manager of Aviation to grant access and construction work permits/licenses to any entity needing access for construction work on the Central Park Blvd Interchange with I-70, 56th Ave. and throughout Stapleton for public works projects.

F-2. Approve revocation of Ordinance #604, Series of 1989 which granted a revocable permit to Colorado Cold Storage, LLC, their successors and assigns, to encroach into the right of way with Overhead Refrigerant Lines in Right of Way at 1600 W Colfax Avenue. District 9.

F-3. Approve vacation of Gaylord Street at E. 11th Avenue and to reserve easements over a portion of the vacated area. District 10.

F-4. Approve Request for Relinquishment of Easement in Vacated S. Race Street Between Evans Ave and Asbury Ave. District 7.

G-1. *Accepts, transfers and appropriates revenue from Gateway Impact Fees and the High Point Metro District to the appropriate Gateway area project accounts; establishes new fund numbers for roads and drainage subareas; and establishes a new fund to accept and appropriate funds from Stapleton Business Center District for its 56th Ave. project share.

G-2. Approve land acquisition for Central Denver Recreation Center.

H-1. *Amends the Versaterm contract implementing the Denver Police Department Records Management System software to change certain deliverables and reduce the contract by \$63,860 since some functions will be grant funded.
