Road Closure Update From Denver Public Works

Two additional events have been scheduled for Sunday, August 24th, with the third event planned for Thursday, August 28th. Road closures resulting from these events are detailed below, and an updated spreadsheet with all announced road closures is attached.

Sunday, August 24

- 10:30 a.m.: ReCreate 68's "No War/No Occupation March"
- 2:00 p.m.: Tent State University's "Alliance for Real Democracy Anti-War March"

Both events will follow one parade route: Colfax & Bannock to Speer Boulevard; Speer Boulevard to Auraria Parkway, Auraria Parkway to 7th Street.

These events will result in the following street closures on Sunday, August 24:

- 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. - Bannock Street will be closed between 14th Avenue and Colfax Avenue
- 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. - The westbound lanes of Colfax Avenue from Bannock Street to Speer Boulevard will be closed, as will the southbound lanes of Speer Boulevard from I-25 to Colfax Avenue.

Please note that Colfax Avenue and Speer Boulevard will not be completely closed; the eastbound lanes of Colfax Avenue and the northbound lanes of Speer will remain open.

The RTD light rail line which crosses Speer Boulevard at Stout Street will remain open at all times, including the time allocated for parades.

Thursday, August 28

- 9 a.m.: Escuela Tlatelolco's "We Are America Immigration Rights March"

Route: Howard Place to Federal Boulevard to West Colfax. West Colfax Avenue to Mariposa Street, Mariposa Street to La Alma/Lincoln Park.

This event will result in the following street closures which were previously announced to accommodate Thursday's events at Invesco Field:

- 9:00 a.m. until the conclusion of events at Invesco Field - Colfax Avenue from Mariposa Street to Federal Boulevard will be closed. Westbound Colfax Avenue will be detoured to Kalamath Street. Eastbound Colfax Avenue will be detoured at southbound Federal Boulevard
- 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. - One northbound Federal Boulevard traffic lane – from Colfax Avenue to 20th Avenue will be closed, however one northbound lane of Federal Boulevard – and all of southbound Federal Boulevard - will remain open throughout the parades which conclude at 3 p.m.
