

Airport Improvement Projects Grant – 2 of 2

Purpose of Funds: The Airport Improvement Program (AIP) provides grants to public agencies — and, in some cases, to private owners and entities -- for the planning and development of public-use airports that are included in the [National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems \(NPIAS\)](#).

Receiving Department: Denver International Airport

Amount: \$4,489,922

Type of Grant: Competitive

Estimated Jobs Created/Retained: 41 jobs retained

Public Process:

For security reasons DIA does not take public input on infrastructure projects. They will give regular progress reports to the Oversight Committee and we will post them on our website. DIA also updates the City Council Economic Development Committee regularly on projects at DIA.

Proposed Spending:

This grant will be used to rehabilitate drainage systems on the terminal taxiways and apron and widen runway 17L-35R's shoulders to accommodate larger Aircraft in Design Group V aircrafts.
