

Denver Regional Council of City Governments – Grant to Improve Denver’s Bicycle Exchange Program and Bikeways

Purpose of Funding: Enhancement is a federal funding category for activities that increase the benefits of a transportation project. Examples include pedestrian or bicycle facilities, landscaping or other scenic beautification projects, historic preservation, control and removal of outdoor advertising, archaeological planning and research, and mitigation of water pollution due to highway runoff.

Amount: \$250,000

Locations with new bike lane installations:

- Mariposa Street - 8th to Colfax Avenues
- Larimer - Broadway to Downing
- Champa - 19th to 24th Streets
- Welton - Colfax to 14th Street
- Tremont - 16th Street to Broadway
- Stout - 30th Street to Downing
- 31st Ave - Downing to Race
- MLK - Elizabeth to Quebec
- Yale - Syracuse Way to Quebec Street
- 22nd Ave - Park Ave to York St
- East 12th Ave - Clayton to Madison

Locations with upgrades of existing bike lane pavement markings:

- 7th Avenue - Colorado Blvd. to Williams St.
- Marion Parkway - Virginia to Bayaud Avenues
- 16th Avenue between Broadway and Esplanade
