**Proc. 25, Series of 2009, A proclamation in recognition of Charlie Meredith on the occasion of his retirement.**

## Bills for Introduction - (Series of 2009)

**C.B. 310, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance designating the Amter Residence, located at 222 South Fairfax Street, as a structure for preservation. (BLUEPRINT DENVER)**

Designates the Amter residence, 222 S. Fairfax, as a structure for preservation in Council District 5. **PUBLIC HEARING AT LEAST ONE WEEK FOLLOWING PASSAGE ON FIRST READING.** The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 5-13-09.

**C.B. 311, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance designating The American Woodmen's Life Building, located at 2100 Downing Street, as a structure for preservation. (BLUEPRINT DENVER)**

Designates The American Woodmen's Life Building, 2100 Downing, as a structure for preservation in Council District 8. **PUBLIC HEARING AT LEAST ONE WEEK FOLLOWING PASSAGE ON FIRST READING.** The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 5-27-09.

**C.B. 312, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance changing the zoning classification of 3830-3834, 3718, 3716, 3714, and 3712 West 32nd Avenue and 3141 Meade Street. (BLUEPRINT DENVER)**

Appl. 2009I-00002. Changes the zoning of a sliver of each of the six parcels described above from R-2 to B-2 to correct an error in the zoning map in Council District 1. **PUBLIC HEARING AT LEAST FOUR WEEKS FOLLOWING PASSAGE ON FIRST READING.** The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 5-27-09.

**C.B. 313, Series of 2009, A bill for an Ordinance amending Ordinance Number 426, Series of 2007, concerning the projects to be undertaken and funded with the proceeds of the Better Denver bonds. (BOND IMPLEMENTATION)**

Amends the Better Denver Bond companion ordinance in the following particulars: In Purpose 6, transfer all funds from the Broadway/I-25 and the Broadway/I-25/Mississippi projects to the I-70/Central Park Blvd interchange, bringing that project amount to \$10 million; change 40<sup>th</sup>/40<sup>th</sup> station to 38<sup>th</sup>/Blake; and in Purpose 5, correct reference to Fire Station #6 rather than #16. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 6-3-09.

**C.B. 314, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Purchase Order between the City and County of Denver and ACS Transport Solutions Inc. for new parking system control equipment at Denver International Airport. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)**

Approves purchase of new parking system control equipment from ACS Transport Solutions for \$1,975,648, including ticket machines, exit gates, credit card in/out units, license plate recognition equipment and additional signage. This will provide all parking facilities at DIA with the most up-to-date technology, allowing parking patrons to use credit cards at unmanned parking facility entry/exit points. The scope of the purchase includes ticket machines, exit gates, credit card in/out units, license plate recognition equipment and additional signage. The locations for this equipment are the East and West Garage and Economy Lot entries and exits at DIA. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-29-09.** The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 5-29-09.

**C.B. 315, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving an Amendment between the City and County of Denver and Cedar Crestone for additional consulting services for PeopleSoft. (FINANCE)**

Approves a contract extension to the PeopleSoft Human Capital Management upgrade agreement through December 31, 2009 and adds \$42,800 for additional consulting services for the PeopleSoft Human Capital Management project. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-29-09.** The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 5-8-09.

**C.B. 316, Series of 2009, A bill for an Ordinance approving a proposed Contract to Exchange Property between the City and County of Denver and Tri-B Associates. (FINANCE)**

Approves exchanging one parcel of City-owned land to Tri-B Associates in return for one parcel of land as part of the Washington Street Bridge Project. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-29-09.** The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 11-7-08.

**C.B. 317, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance amending the classification and pay plan for employees in the Career Service and for certain employees not in the Career Service. (GENERAL GOVERNMENT)**

Changes the pay grade for Aviation Customer Service Supervisor Classification from 806-S to 807-S. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 5-22-09.

**C.B. 318, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving an Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Regents of the University of Colorado, A Body Corporate, Acting on Behalf of the Kempe Children's Center, Department of Pediatrics, University of Colorado School of Medicine, to improve therapeutic services to children and their families who experience traumatic events. (NEIGHBORHOOD, COMMUNITY & BUSINESS REVITALIZATION)**

Authorizes a twelve month extension through September 30, 2009 to an agreement with Regents of the University of Colorado, and to increase the contract by \$323,526 to provide Child Parent Psychotherapy (CPP) services to abused and neglected children. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-29-09.** The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 5-1-09.

**C.B. 319, Series of 2009, A bill for an Ordinance approving an Amendatory Agreement with Mike Quintana Sr., d/b/a Sloans Lake Boxing Club to use the Gun Club Building at Sloan's Lake Park for an Amateur Boxing Club. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Extends existing agreement with Sloans Lake Boxing Club regarding occupancy of the Gun Club Building at Sloan's Lake Park for one year with 3 additional one-year extensions, subject to a 90-day termination clause. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-29-09.** The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 4-24-09.

**C.B. 320, Series of 2009, A bill for an Ordinance approving an Amendment of Concession License to Biker Jim's/Waffle Brothers LLC for the operation of a concession at the Pavilion at Skyline Park. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Amends the Concession License for Biker Jim's Concessions LLC to change the name to Biker Jim's/Waffle Brothers LLC for the concession at 16<sup>th</sup> and Arapahoe. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-29-09.** The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 4-24-09.

**C.B. 321, Series of 2009, A bill for an Ordinance revoking the existing revocable permit granted by Ordinance No. 148, Series of 2004, to FC Asset Property Managers, LLC to encroach into the alley between 30th and 31st Streets and into Curtis Street. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Revokes the permit granted to FC asset Property Managers to encroach with an existing building into the alley between 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> streets and into Curtis St. public right-of-way because the building has been demolished and a portion of the alley has been vacated in Council District 8. This bill was approved for filing at the Mayor-Council meeting on 6-2-09.

**C.B. 322, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance relinquishing all easements in the described area at Denargo Market. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Relinquishes easements established in 1880, 1937 and 1987 in the Denargo Market redevelopment area bounded by Broadway, 29<sup>th</sup> St., Arkins Ct., and Denargo St. in Council District 9. This bill was approved for filing at the Mayor-Council meeting on 5-19-09. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-29-09.** This bill was approved for filing at the Mayor-Council meeting on 6-2-09.

**C.B. 323, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance creating the Tennyson Streetscape Local Maintenance District (West 38th Avenue to West 44th Avenue) for the continuing care, operation, repair, maintenance and replacement of local public improvements, with the costs to be assessed upon the real property benefited. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves creation of the Tennyson Street Streetscape Local Maintenance District located generally between W. 38<sup>th</sup> to W. 44<sup>th</sup> avenues for the purpose of maintaining improvements to be constructed with Better Denver Bond funds, including decorative sidewalk paving and curb edging, street furniture, tree grates and trees, and pedestrian lighting. **PUBLIC HEARING AT LEAST ONE WEEK FOLLOWING PASSAGE ON FIRST READING.** The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 6-2-09.

**C.B. 324, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving an agreement between Concrete Works of Colorado, Inc. and the City & County of Denver for the reconstruction of So. Broadway Street from Arizona to Iowa Streets. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves a \$5,960,187.31 contract with Concrete Works of Co., Inc., for the reconstruction of South Broadway between Arizona and Iowa, including concrete pavement; minor realignment; left turn lanes; raised medians where turn lanes do not exist; traffic signals; lighting; bus shelters; bike racks and landscaping. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-29-09.** The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 5-29-09.

**C.B. 325, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving an on-call amendatory agreement between Fentress Architects, Ltd. and the City & County of Denver to provide general design services. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Extends term of On Call Contract with Fentress Architects from 7-3-09 to 7-3-11 and increases capacity from \$480,000 to \$960,000. General Services works with almost all agencies and provides design and construction repair service with the On Call system. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-29-09.** The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 5-29-09.

**C.B. 326, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed contract between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado, Department of Transportation, concerning the "South Broadway Reconstruction, Asbury Avenue to Wesley Avenue" project and the funding therefor. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves an Intergovernmental Agreement with Colorado Dept. of Transportation authorizing receipt of \$476,273 and appropriation of the revenue to the appropriate fund for the design and environmental analysis for reconstruction of S. Broadway between Asbury and Wesley. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 5-29-09.

**C.B. 327, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed contract between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado, Department of Transportation, concerning the "Evans Avenue Improvements, Broadway to Evans LRT Station" project and the funding therefor. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves an Intergovernmental Agreement with Colorado Dept. of Transportation authorizing receipt of \$243,395 and appropriation of the revenue to the appropriate fund for the design and environmental analysis for reconstruction of Evans from Broadway to the Evans light rail station near Delaware. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 5-29-09.

**C.B. 328, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Fourth Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and BI Incorporated, for equipment and services. (SAFETY)**

Adds \$1,750,000 to the contract with Behavioral Interventions, Inc. for equipment and services for the City's Electronic Monitoring Program. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-29-09.** The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 5-29-09.

Tonight Council will hold a one-hour courtesy public hearing on C.B. 125, Series of 2009, and required public hearings on C.B.s 245 and 246, Series of 2009. Final Consideration

C.B. 245 and 246, Series of 2009, approve zoning map amendments. The Council is required by law to conduct hearings on zoning map amendments, and Council’s actions are subject to court review. In order to provide a record for court review, testimony is recorded and any items presented to the Council are marked as exhibits and become a part of the record. They may be picked up from the Council Secretary after 30 days or after the conclusion of any court cases. Speakers should begin their remarks by telling the Council their names and cities of residence, and if they feel comfortable doing so, their home addresses.

COURTESY PUBLIC HEARING ONE-HOUR **C.B. 125, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving the Sheridan Station Area Plan, which plan shall become a part of the Comprehensive Plan for the City and County of Denver pursuant to the provisions of Section 12-61 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code. (FASTRACKS)**

Adopts the Sheridan Station Area Plan as a supplement to the Denver Comprehensive Plan 2000 to guide land use, urban design and mobility improvements and investments around the light rail station.

REQUIRED PUBLIC HEARING **C.B. 245, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance changing the zoning classification for 270 South Madison Street to a Planned Unit Development District (PUD). (BLUEPRINT DENVER)**

Appl. 2008I-00015. Changes the zoning of the 0.14-acre parcel at 270 S. Madison from R-1 to PUD in Council District 10.

REQUIRED PUBLIC HEARING **C.B. 246, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance changing the zoning classification of 151-175 South Harrison Street from R-1 to PUD. (BLUEPRINT DENVER)**

Appl. 2008I-00057. Changes the zoning of the 0.57-acre parcel at 151-175 S. Harrison from R-1 to PUD in Council District 10.

**C.B. 289, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving an agreement between Haselden Construction, LLC and the City & County of Denver to construct a new Police Traffic Operation and Firing Range at 3501 Park Avenue, Denver, Colorado. (BOND IMPLEMENTATION)**

Approves an \$8,550,952 construction management/general contractor contract with Haselden Construction for relocation of Police Traffic Operations and Firing Range from 1390 Decatur to 3501 Park Ave. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.**

**C.B. 290, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Lease between the City and County of Denver and Denver Health and Hospital Authority concerning Medical Clinic at Denver International Airport. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)**

Approves the lease agreement between Denver Health and the City for the medical clinic in the Jeppesen Terminal through December 31, 2009, with a one-year option to December 31, 2010 for annual rent in the amount of \$171,954. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.**

**C.B. 291, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Non-Disturbance and Attornment Agreement between the City and County of Denver, Skyport Development Company, LLC, and Juan Kona, LLC concerning a concession at Denver International Airport. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)**

Approves execution of a non-disturbance and attornment agreement between Skyport Development Company and Juan Kona, LLC dba Jet Pet Boutique to allow the sub-lessee to maintain possession of the concession space if Skyport Development defaults on their lease agreement with the airport and outlines the terms of payment directly to the airport. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.** The term lease is from July 1, 2009 to August 1, 2011 plus options.

**C.B. 292, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Non-Disturbance and Attornment Agreement between the City and County of Denver, Skyport Development Company, LLC, and Edge 1 Cellular, LP concerning a concession at Denver International Airport. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)**

Approves execution of a non-disturbance and attornment agreement between Skyport Development Company and Edge 1 Cellular, LP dba I-Tech to allow the sub-lessee to maintain possession of the concession space if Skyport Development defaults on their lease agreement with the airport and outlines the terms of payment directly to the airport. The term lease is from August 1, 2009 to October 31, 2017. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.**

**C.B. 293, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Non-Disturbance and Attornment Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Skyport Development Company, LLC, and Crocodile Kiosk, LLC concerning a concession at Denver International Airport. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)**

Approves execution of a non-disturbance and attornment agreement between Skyport Development Company and Crocodile Kiosk, LLC dba Crocs to allow the sub-lessee to maintain possession of the concession space if Skyport Development defaults on their lease agreement with the airport and outlines the terms of payment directly to the airport. The term lease is from August 1, 2009 to October 31, 2017. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.**

**C.B. 294, Series of 2009**, A bill for an ordinance to correct a transcription error contained in the City Clerk Filing Number for Ordinance No. 234, Series of 2009, approving a proposed Sixth Amendment to Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Quiz-DIA, LLC. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)

Approves a sixth amendment to the Quiz-DIA, LLC contract to correct a technical error. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.**

**C.B. 295, Series of 2009**, A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed First Amendment to Agreement for Shuttle Bus Management Services at Denver International Airport between the City and County of Denver and Ampco System Parking DBA Ampco System Transportation Services. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)

Changes the agreement with AMPCO for shuttle bus services at DIA to: 1) Allow future fee adjustments via standard operating procedures; 2) Reflect the new oversight department (Revenue Development); 3) Adjust fees for current contract year; 4) Change pricing form exhibit to allow better matching of supply and demand; 5) Allow contractor to request less than Consumer Price Index for fee change; and 6) Change part-time employee cap to 15% from 10%. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.**

**C.B. 297, Series of 2009**, A bill for an ordinance relating to Chapter 20, Denver Revised Municipal Code, to amend the procedure for approving internal audits. (FINANCE)

Amends Section 20-276 of the Revised Municipal Code to add language that would allow the Auditor's Office in cases of suspected or potential criminal activity to share information with the District Attorney's Office prior to the release of an audit report to the public.

**C.B. 298, Series of 2009**, A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed First Amendment to Fiscal Year 2009 Amendment to the Amended and Restated Operating Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Denver Health and Hospital Authority amending Appendix A-2, Emergency Medical Services. (FINANCE)

Amends Appendix A-2 of the Operating Agreement to incorporate specific performance criteria and evaluation methods for emergency medical response. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.**

**C.B. 299, Series of 2009**, A bill for an ordinance making a supplemental appropriation from the General Contingency Fund to the Department of Safety, Undersheriff. (FINANCE)

Authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the General Contingency Fund of \$856,000 to the Manager of Safety to reconcile 2008 expenditure for services provided by Denver Health.

**C.B. 300, Series of 2009, A bill for an Ordinance approving a Cooperative Agreement with the Denver Police Activities League, Inc., regarding construction and use of playing fields at Val Verde and Parkfield Park. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)**

Approves a \$3.6 million agreement with the Police Activities League regarding use of funds donated by Bill Daniels for athletic fields and related amenities at Val Verde Park in District 7 and Parkfield Park in District 11. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.**

**C.B. 301, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving an on-call agreement between Wilderness Construction Co. and the City & County of Denver that will provide general construction services. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves a 4-year, on-call, small scope construction services contract with Wilderness Construction, requiring at least 25% of work to be by certified Small Business Enterprise. Maximum contract amount is \$1.5 M; most work orders are limited to \$75,000. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.**

**C.B. 302, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving an on-call agreement between Diamond Hills Services, Inc. and the City & County of Denver that will provide general construction services. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves a 4-year, on-call, small scope construction services contract with Diamond Hills Services, requiring at least 25% of work to be by certified Small Business Enterprise. Maximum contract amount is \$1.5 M; most work orders are limited to \$75,000. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.**

**C.B. 303, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving an on-call agreement between Norkoli Construction, Inc. and the City & County of Denver that will provide general construction services. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves a 4-year, on-call, small scope construction services contract with Norkoli Construction, requiring at least 25% of work to be by certified Small Business Enterprise. Maximum contract amount is \$1.5 M; most work orders are limited to \$75,000. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.**

**C.B. 304, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving an on-call agreement between Rhinotrax Construction, Inc. and the City & County of Denver that will provide general construction services. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Approves a 4-year, on-call, small scope construction services contract with Rhinotrax Construction, requiring at least 25% of work to be by certified Small Business Enterprise. Maximum contract amount is \$1.5 M; most work orders are limited to \$75,000. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.**

**C.B. 305, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance making rescissions and appropriations in the Grant Projects Fund for Broadway TIP projects. (PUBLIC WORKS)**

Rescinds \$880,000 from a Treasury account; transfers that amount to the Local Improvement District Construction Fund in Public Works; and appropriates \$910,000 from that fund for construction projects on Broadway.

**C.B. 307, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Second Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Century Helicopters, Inc., for scheduled and non-scheduled maintenance of the Denver Police Department's helicopters. (SAFETY)**

Amends the current agreement between the City and Century Helicopter, Inc. by adding \$672,571 for maintenance of the Denver Police Department Bell 407 helicopter and the on-board avionic systems; to provide a rental aircraft/engine during longer periods of scheduled down-time; and to extend the agreement until May 31, 2011. Total contract will be \$1,777,516 with the amendment. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.**

**C.B. 308, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Second Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado, Judicial Department, to fund four positions to support drug court. (SAFETY)**

Accepts an additional \$251,505.05 to the existing contract with the State of Colorado Judicial Department for funding of four positions to support the Drug Court. **The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-22-09.**

**C.B. 309, Series of 2009, A bill for an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 229, Series of 2009, concerning the "High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) FY09" Program. (SAFETY)**

Corrects the fund number of the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) FY09 program ordinance.
