A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing expenditures in the Economic Opportunity Special Revenue Fund for the "Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Case Management, Employment, and Training FY09-10" program.

WHEREAS, the Office of Economic Development, Division of Workforce Development, provides case management services through the Employment and Training program for TANF participants; and

WHEREAS, the Denver Department of Human Services reimburses the Office of Economic Development for said services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Expenditures are hereby authorized from the Economic Opportunity Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 17000, the amounts of money in the following tabulation to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
