A BILL

For an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed grant agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States of America concerning the "Solving Cold Cases with DNA FY09" program and the funding therefore, and authorizing the purchase of capital equipment.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement, under CFDA No. 16.560, between the United States of America and the City and County of Denver, which is identified as Grant Number 2009-DN-BX-K012, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 09-1031, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The Mayor or his lawful successor and other proper officials of the City and County of Denver, in its behalf, are hereby authorized and directed to execute said Grant Agreement and the Clerk and Recorder of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to attest and impress the official seal of the City and County of Denver on the Grant Agreement.

Section 3. The Mayor, his successor in office, or his duly authorized representatives, and other officials of the City are hereby authorized and directed to do all things required to be done in order to obtain payments under the Grant Agreement, including, but not limited to, filing requests for payments, contracting with persons and organizations in order to carry out the provisions of the Grant Agreement, filing reports and keeping records relating to fiscal and evaluation matters, and forwarding other materials to the United States of America.

Section 4. The payments made by the United States of America to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 12000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

1 Section 5. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said
2 "Solving Cold Cases with DNA FY09" Program, Accounting No. 12220-3518101-S1104 is as
3 follows, to be expended by the Manager of Safety:

6 Authorization for expenditure of said funds following execution of said grant will cover the period
7 from November 1, 2009 to April 30, 2011.

8 Section 6. From the "Solving Cold Cases with DNA FY09" Special Revenue Fund,
9 Accounting No. 12220-3518101-S1104, the Mayor, or his duly authorized representatives, is
10 hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment items:

11 1 DNA extraction robot

12 Section 7. The Manager of Finance of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized
13 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be
14 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
