A BILL

For an ordinance accepting funding from the United States of America for the "State Criminal Alien Assistance Programs (SCAAP)" for Fiscal Year 2009 and authorizing expenditures therefor.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed special allocation of funds from the United States of America, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP) for Fiscal Year 2009, Grant No. 2009-AP-BX-0476, under CFDA No., 16.606, be and hereby is accepted in all respects, in accordance with the document filed with the City Clerk, Filing No.09-1101.

Section 2. The payments made by the United States of America as a special allocation of funds shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and County of Denver and credited to Special Fund No. 12000 which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. Expenditures are hereby authorized from the Safety Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 12000, in the amounts of money in the following tabulation to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
