A RESOLUTION

Laying out, opening and establishing as part of the city street system a parcel of land as South Quebec Street, between Alameda Avenue and vacated Kentucky Lane.

WHEREAS, the Manager of Public Works of the City and County of Denver has found and determined that the public use, convenience and necessity require the laying out, opening and establishing as a public street designated as part of the system of thoroughfares of the municipality those portions of real property hereinafter more particularly described, and, subject to approval by resolution has laid out, opened and established the same as a public street;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the action of the Manager of Public Works in laying out, opening and establishing as part of the system of thoroughfares of the municipality the following described portions of real property situate, lying and being in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, to wit:

A PARCEL OF LAND AS SHOWN ON THAT ANNEXATION PLAT, PARTS OF SECTIONS 15, 16, 17, 20, AND 21, TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 67 WEST OF THE 6TH P. M., ORIGINALLY IN ARAPAHOE COUNTY AS ACCEPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER BY ORDINANCE 271 OF 1963 AND RECORDED AT BOOK 24, PAGE 79 IN THE RECORDS OF THE CLERK AND RECORDER, CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER, STATE OF COLORADO, BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS:

THE WEST 30 FEET OF SAID SECTION 16 AS SHOWN ON SAID ANNEXATION PLAT BETWEEN ALAMEDA AND KENTUCKY.

be and the same is hereby approved and said portions of real property are hereby laid out and established and declared laid out, opened and established as South Quebec Street.

Section 2. That the real property described in Section 1 hereof shall henceforth be known as South Quebec Street.
