5 **A BILL**

6 **For an ordinance to amend Chapter 32 to update retail license fees and to**
7 **add occupational privilege tax registration fees.**

8 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Finance has a combined application for retail license and the
9 occupational privilege registration;

10 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Finance has performed a study of its fees for processing of these
11 applications and administration of the related taxes;

12 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Finance study has determined that the cost to the Department of
13 Finance for administering the sales, use, lodger's taxes covered by the retail license and
14 occupational privilege taxes totals on a biennial basis \$2,854,962.00;

15 **WHEREAS**, the current fees adopted in 1993 currently cover only 10% to 15% of the
16 administration expense; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the increases contained in this ordinance will raise the fees collected on a biennial
18 basis to approximately \$2,277,500.00 and therefore defray a greater percentage of the
19 administration costs for the Department of Finance.

20 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**
21 **DENVER:**

23 **Section 1.** That Chapter 32-107(1), "Retail sales", of the Revised Municipal Code is hereby
24 amended by adding the language underlined and deleting the language stricken as follows:

25 **Sec. 32-107. Retail sales license and occupational tax registration.**

26 (1) (a) Every employer within the city, as well as every employer situated outside of the city
27 who engages in business within the city and every person engaged in any business, trade,
28 occupation, profession or calling of any kind having a fixed or transitory situs within the city, for
29 any period of time in a calendar month within the city shall file an occupational tax registration
30 with the department of finance.

31 (b) A retail sales license and occupational tax registration shall, unless sooner revoked, be in
32 effect until the thirty-first day of December of odd-numbered years following or during the year in
33 which it is issued. An applicant may file for either the license or for the registration or for both the
34 license and the registration, applicable to the applicant's business.

35 ~~(b)~~ (c) It is the duty of each licensee and each registrant on or before January first of even-
36 numbered years following the year in which his the license or registration is issued or renewed to
37 obtain a renewal thereof if the licensee remains in retail business or liable to account as a retailer
38 for the tax provided in either the city retail sales tax article, the city lodger's tax article, or the city
39 use tax article or if the registrant remains in business or liable to account for the tax as provided

1 in either the city employee occupational privilege tax article or in the business occupational
2 privilege tax article.

3 ~~(e) (d)~~ For each license issued, a fee of ~~twenty dollars (\$20.00)~~ fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be
4 paid, which fee shall accompany the application. A further fee of ~~twenty dollars (\$20.00)~~ fifty
5 dollars (\$50.00) shall be paid for each two-year period beginning in even-numbered years for
6 which such license is renewed. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 32-6 of this Code,
7 payment of a fee for such a license issued after June thirtieth of even-numbered years shall be
8 prorated in decrements of ~~five dollars (\$5.00)~~ twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50) for each
9 succeeding six-month period following June thirtieth of the even-numbered year as set forth in
10 the following table:

13 All licenses shall be renewed on a biennial basis, effective January 1, 1994.

15 (e) For each occupational tax registration, unless otherwise exempted by this article, a fee of
16 fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be paid, which fee shall accompany the registration. A further fee of
17 fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be paid for each two-year period beginning in even-numbered years for
18 which such registration is renewed. An occupational tax registrant is exempt from paying the
19 registration fee only, if in the twelve month period prior to the registration year the registrant
20 owed less than thirty dollars (\$30.00) in combined employee occupational privilege tax and
21 business occupational privilege tax. All registrations shall be renewed on a biennial basis,
22 effective January 1, 2010, though a uniform extension may be granted to all registrants by the
23 manager of finance for the initial year only.
