

ADUs in Denver Advisory Committee

If selected for the advisory committee, members should expect to meet 6 to 8 times over the next 10 to 12 months (roughly once every month and a half). Each meeting will last approximately two hours. Meetings will be conducted virtually via Zoom, unless guidelines change.

Selection Criteria

The ideal committee will include approximately 15-20 Denver residents. Applications will be considered based on how well they meet the following criteria:

- Racial and ethnic diversity
- A broad range of ages
- Geographic diversity, i.e. suburban vs urban neighborhood contexts
- Gender diversity
- Income diversity
- Diversity of housing types, i.e. residents who rent vs. own their homes

Additionally, a well-rounded steering committee should include differing viewpoints that represent the variety of values held within the diverse neighborhoods of Denver. Applications will be considered with the goal of including advocates for:

- Affordable housing
- Sustainability
- Youth and family advocacy
- Architecture that fits in the neighborhood context
- Alternative living arrangements
- Anti-displacement strategies
- Community groups
- Neighborhood organizations
