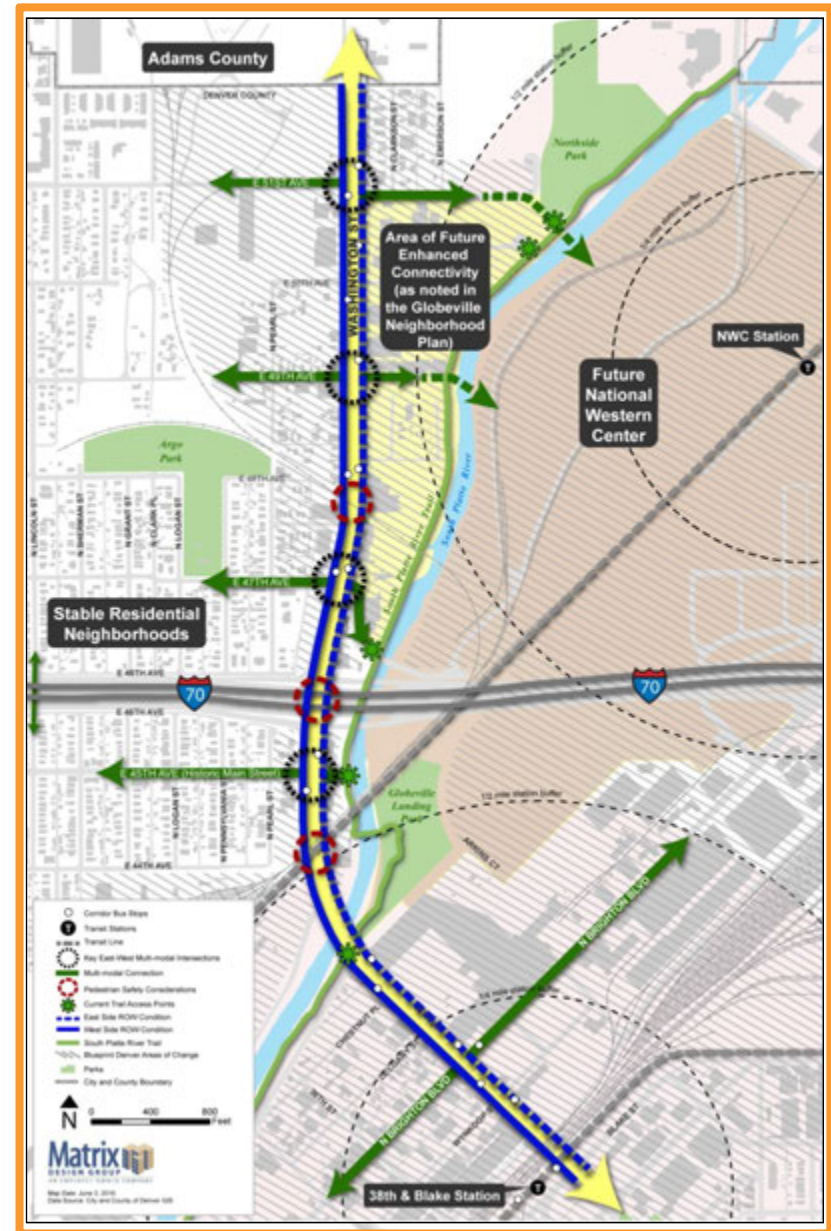

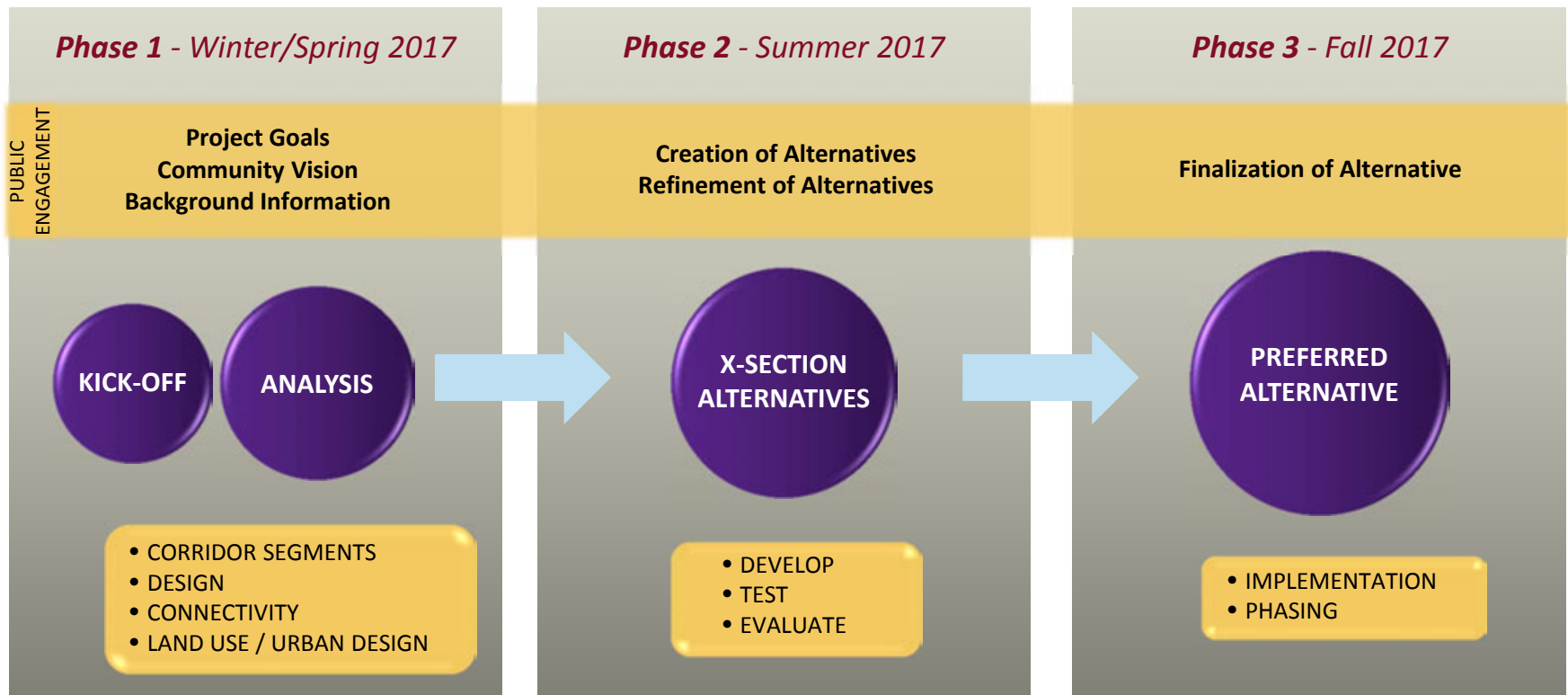


Study Area & Intent

- Identified in the Globeville Neighborhood Plan as a Transformative Project
- Address the changing land uses and the future vision for the corridor as a mixed use street
- Washington Street has the opportunity to establish a neighborhood identity and catalyze redevelopment and reinvestment in the area
- Develop a preferred alternative for implementation that realizing the vision of the corridor.

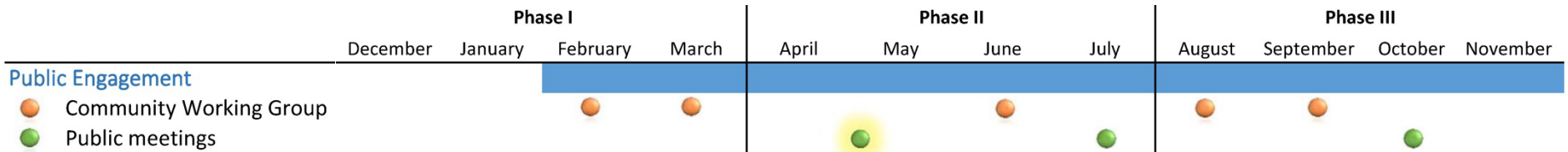


Process
