

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 99

Subject: City Smoking Policy

Purpose: This Executive Order establishes the smoking policy in city-owned, or city-managed facilities and offices. Executive Order No. 99, "City Smoking Policy", dated December 1, 1993 is hereby canceled and superseded by this Executive Order No. 99, City Smoking Policy dated May 6, 2015.


- 1.0 For purposes of this Executive Order, the term "smoking" shall include the use of any device that can be used to deliver tobacco or nicotine to the person inhaling from the device, including electronic cigarettes, cigars, cigarillos or pipes, as well as vaporizers, hookah pens and similar devices that use an atomizer or otherwise allow users to inhale nicotine vapor without the use of fire, smoke or ash.
 - 1.1 Smoking within any city-owned or managed facility, including smoking in public and private city offices, courts, and other indoor buildings not otherwise specified herein shall be prohibited and regulated as provided in **C.R.S. 25-14-201** (Colorado Clean Indoor Air Act).
 - 1.2 Smoking is prohibited in all indoor public places at Denver International Airport, including bars, restaurants, and food courts, except in any existing designated smoking lounge in use prior to the passing of this Executive Order. Smoking is prohibited in the tunnel and all restricted access areas.
 - 1.3 Smoking in the county jail and city detention centers shall be regulated by the Department of Safety and the managers in charge of such facilities.
 - 1.4 Smoking within 25 ft of the entrances to any city-owned or managed facility is prohibited.
 - 1.5 Smoking on the grounds of city-owned or managed facilities shall be regulated by the manager in charge of the facility in accordance with the Colorado Clean Indoor Air Act, and with an effort made to reduce exposure to second-hand smoke and second-hand vapor, a by-product of which is an aerosol that may contain harmful toxicants.


- 1.6 Smoking within any city-owned vehicle is prohibited.
- 1.7 The City's Wellness Committee will continue to offer smoking cessation support to City Employees.
- 1.8 Enforcement for City employees violating this order shall be the responsibility of the executive director of the department or agency. Enforcement for the general public shall be the responsibility of the building manager.


