

DISMISSAL ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPEAL OF:

JOHN (JUAN) PATINO, Appellant,

vs.

OFFICE OF THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT FOR ZONING APPEALS,
and the City and County of Denver, a municipal corporation, Agency.

The Appellant filed his appeal on August 6, 2010. Jurisdictional issues were apparent from the appeal. An employee must have Career Service status in order to invoke the jurisdiction of the Career Service Hearing Office "except on grounds of discrimination or violation of the "Whistleblower Protection" ordinance". CSR § 5-64 2. Consequently the Appellant was ordered to show cause, by August 19, 2010, why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. The Appellant did not respond.

Accordingly, this appeal is hereby DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE for lack of jurisdiction.
