Synopsis: On the afternoon of August 15, 1980 Denver Police Officers responded to the N. Platte River at East 48th Avenue on a report of a dead body. Upon arrival, officers observed the victim lying on a sandbar in the North Platte River. After the autopsy was complete it was determined that the victim died as a result of blunt force trauma to his head. The victim was subsequently identified by fingerprints as Travis B. McGilvray; a local business owner and operator of M & G Electronics.

The Denver Police Department's Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
