How and when do I register to vote?

Colorado allows and encourages pre-registration of all eligible voters beginning at the age of 15. You can register at **GOVOTECOLORADO.GOV**, when you get your driver's license, or at your high school!

Why is my signature so important?

In Colorado, your identity is verified with the signature you provide on your voter registration form. Make sure your signature is unique to you and consistent with the signature you use when voting, signing your driver's license, and other official documents.

Where can I find election information?

Visit DenverVotes.org for official Denver Elections information. Mis/disinformation is spread to decrease confidence in elections. If you hear something that doesn't sound right, call, email, or check our website to access the correct, official information.

To be eligible to register to vote in Colorado you must be:

- A United States citizen.
- Not currently serving a term of imprisonment for a felony conviction.
- At least 15 years old. You won't be eligible to vote until you are 18 years old.
- A Colorado resident for at least 22 days before the election in which you intend to vote.
