Sewer Stub-In Permit Entrance Requirements

Authority:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✦ Revised Municipal Code (RMC) of the City & County of Denver, Chapter 56, Section 56-41, Purpose (Administrative Authority). ✦ Public Works Rules & Regulations Governing Sewerage Charges and Fees & Management of Wastewater.
Document Date:	May 2, 2013
Permit Dates:	The work must commence within one year of the issuance date of the permit, and there must be no lapses of construction for a period of a year or more.

Considerations:	<p>See the General Guidelines for Sewer Use & Drainage Permits for basic submittal requirements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✦ Sewer Stub-In Permits are a separate, additional permit. ✦ Requested for special circumstances for a “stub” from the sewer mainline to inside the property line and the Sewer Use and Drainage Permit for the structure is not ready to be issued. ✦ This type of permit is used when street is going to be paved and the contractor needs to install all utilities in the right-of-way to avoid cutting into the newly paved street or alley. ✦ The issued SUDP will indicate that it is for Stub-In construction only and will state a supplemental SUDP will be required prior to connection of any future building to the stub-in. ✦ No building connections are allowed with this permit.
Fees:	Application fee of \$100.00 at the time of submittal.
