Permittee shall install initial stormwater control measures then schedule and pass an initial inspection **prior** to any demolition, clearing, grubbing, grading or excavation activity. **To schedule an initial inspection, please contact City and County of Denver (CCD) Stormwater Quality Investigations at 303-446-3485 or [WQInvestigations@denvergov.org](mailto:WQInvestigations@denvergov.org)** at least two (2) business days prior to desired inspection time. This permit expires if initial inspection and start of construction has not commenced within twelve (12) months of issuance.

All construction activities associated with this project shall be subject to the conditions and requirements of the approved Stormwater Management Plan (SWMP); and shall be in compliance with the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver and all applicable Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Rules and Regulations including Chapter 10, City and County of Denver, Department of Transportation and Infrastructure "Rules and Regulations Governing Sewerage Charges and Fees and Management of Wastewater".

Failure to comply with this Permit may result in the imposition of civil penalties (up to \$10,000 per day) pursuant to Denver Revised Municipal Code (DRMC) 56-107. Disputes regarding this permit shall be resolved by administrative hearing pursuant to DRMC 56-106.

Upon completion of construction and final stabilization of the construction site, the permit holder shall submit an "Inactivation Request for Construction Activities Stormwater Discharge Permit" form to Stormwater Quality Investigations at **303-446-3485** or [WQInvestigations@denvergov.org](mailto:WQInvestigations@denvergov.org)

Contact the Right-of-Way Services Construction Inspector **prior** to starting construction if any activities will impact the right-of-way (ROW) adjacent to this site. Any work within the ROW or use of the ROW (including staging, parking of vehicles, stockpiling of materials, etc.) will require a Street Cut, Construction, and/ or Street Occupancy Permit(s) from the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Permit Operations at **303-446-3759** or [DOTIpermitOperations@denvergov.org](mailto:DOTIpermitOperations@denvergov.org) It is the licensed contractor's responsibility to obtain the proper permit(s).

Any work within the Regulatory Floodplain requires a floodplain permit. Floodplain questions can be directed to the City & County of Denver's Floodplain Management Group at [Floodplain@denvergov.org](mailto:Floodplain@denvergov.org) or **720-865-3215**.
