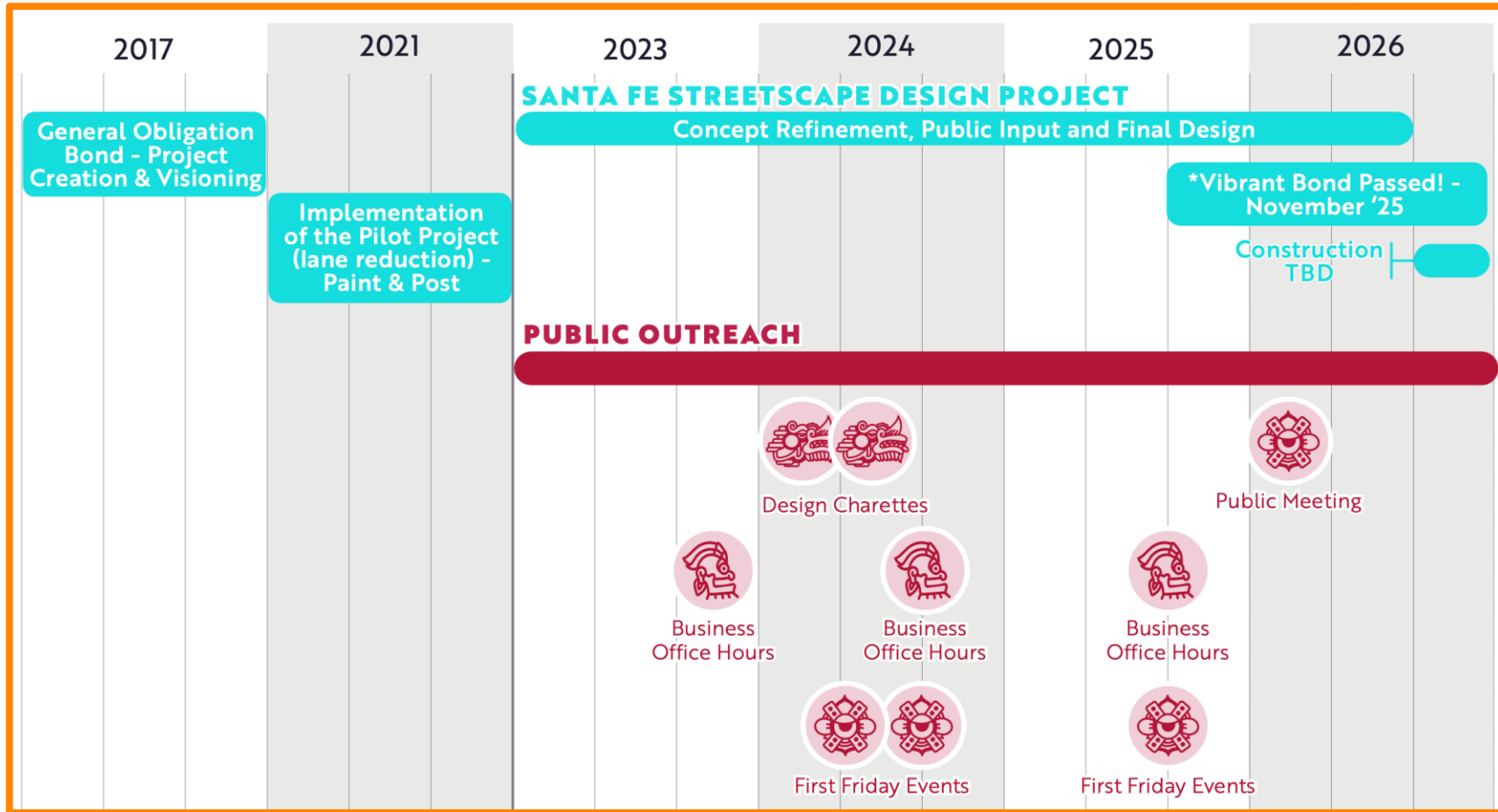

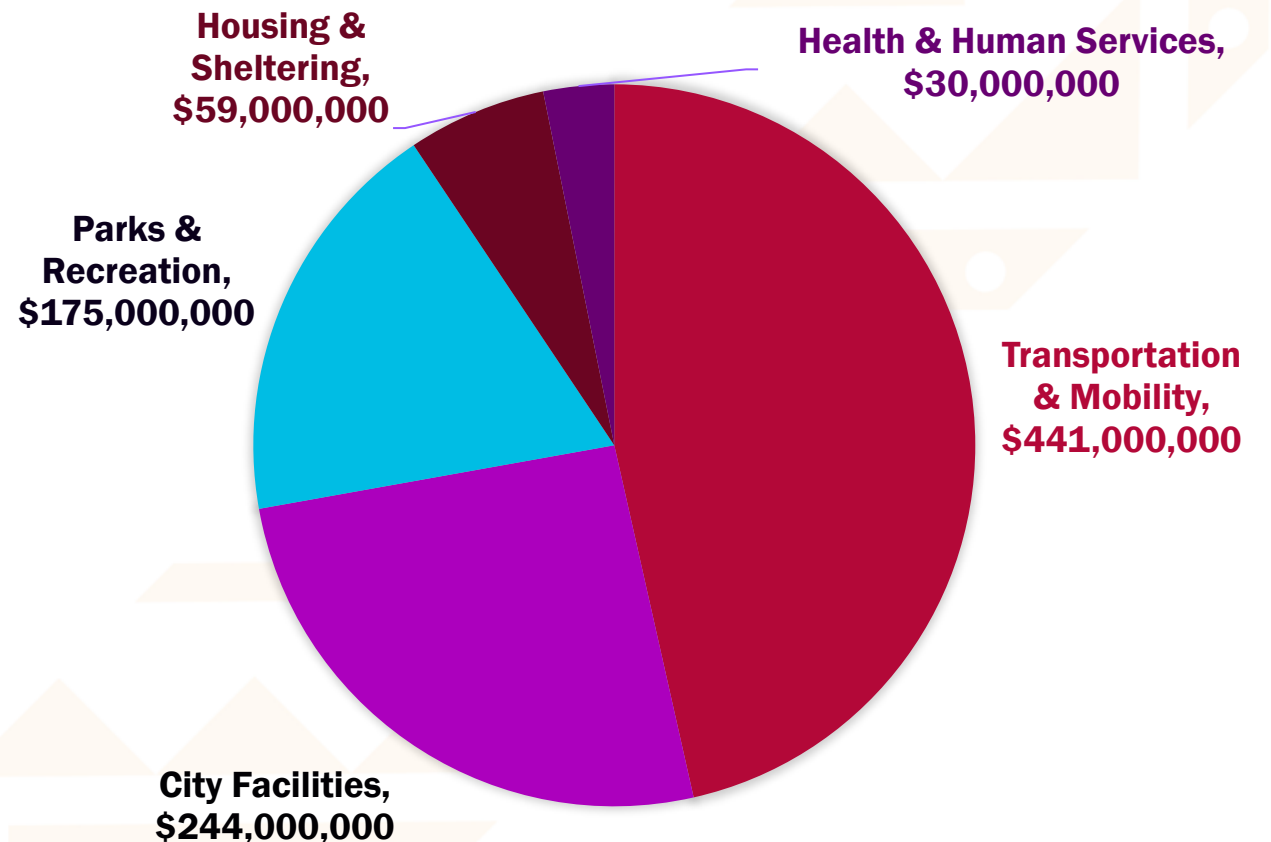

# Vibrant Denver Bond Overview

- \$950 million bond package for citywide infrastructure projects
- 58 named projects
- 5 ballot measures approved by two-thirds of voters in November
- Does **NOT** raise taxes
- 6-year delivery timeframe; all projects complete by 12/2031
