Denver Economic Development & Opportunity's division of Neighborhood Equity and Stabilization, in partnership with The Denver Foundation, has announced the 2024 mini grant program to provide residents and micro businesses with an opportunity to lead the change they would like to see in their communities.

Funding is available for small, community-driven projects designed to strengthen the community, create a stronger and more connected neighborhood, and address community needs.

### ELIGIBILITY

- Grant recipients must reside or work in NEST priority neighborhoods: Athmar Park, Barnum, Barnum West, Clayton, College View, East Colfax, Elyria Swansea, Globeville, Kennedy, Lincoln Park, Mar Lee, Montbello, Ruby Hill, Sun Valley, Valverde, Villa Park, Westwood, and Windsor.
- Organizations or groups applying outside of these neighborhoods must partner with existing groups in the community.
- Micro businesses applying for the grant must operate within the program's priority communities and have an annual revenue of no more than \$500,000.
- A community group does NOT need to be a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization to apply.
