

Dear North Capitol Hill Permit Holder,

The City and County of Denver's Department of Transportation & Infrastructure (DOTI), in partnership with Councilman Hinds, is pleased to inform you that your neighborhood's Residential Parking Permit (RPP) program is transitioning from Block Zone to Area Zone. This change will take effect in February and means that instead of your RPP being valid only on your block, North Capitol Hill residents with a RPP will be allowed to park anywhere within the North Capitol Hill Area Zone.

The North Capitol Hill Area Zone is outlined in orange on the graphic below, and non-paid time-limited spaces (e.g., 1-hour, 2-hour, etc.), where North Capitol Hill Area Zone RPPs are valid, are shown in yellow. Why This Change Is Happening

RPP Area Zones enable DOTI to implement a more accessible RPP program. This change aligns with [Residential Parking Permit Rules & Regulations](#) adopted in 2023 and is also based on feedback received by residents and RPP program participants.

Why This Matters

- **More Flexibility:** You will be able to park on any block within the North Capitol Hill RPP Area Zone, not just on your block.
- **Expanded Eligibility:** Residents in larger multi-unit buildings (up to 50 addresses) are now RPP eligible.
- **Increased RPP Access:** More RPP-eligible spaces are available to North Capitol Hill Area Zone RPP participants.

What This Means for You

- If you have a license plate-based Vehicle-Specific RPP, no action is needed. Your permit remains valid and will be converted to a North Capitol Hill Area Zone RPP.
- If you have a physical Flex Parking Permit (FPP), no action is needed. You may ignore handwritten block references on the physical permit. The permits will be honored in the North Capitol Hill Area Zone if they are not expired. Moving forward, new FPPs issued to North Capitol Hill Area Zone RPP holders will no longer include block references.
- Addresses that are now eligible must apply before receiving permits. Application review and approval may take 4-6 weeks. For more information or to apply, visit [Denver RPP](#).
