

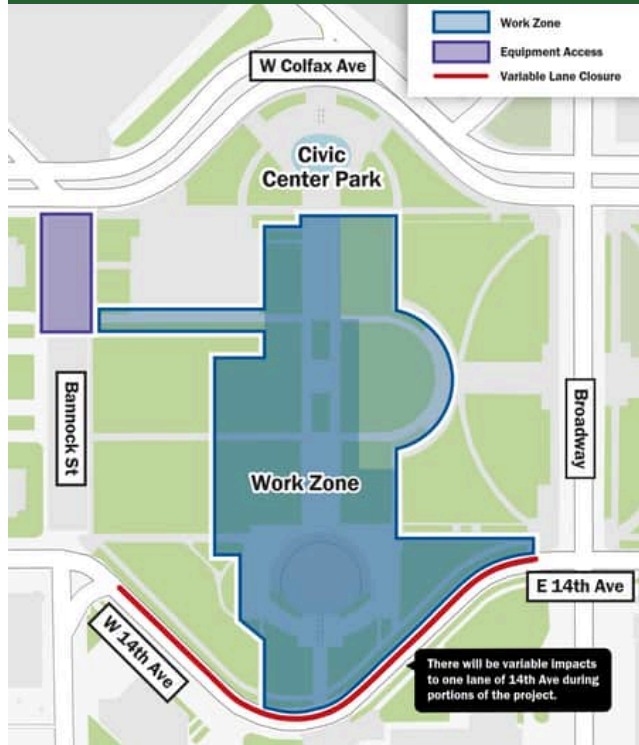


CIVIC CENTER NEXT 100

CONSTRUCTION IS UNDERWAY AT CIVIC CENTER PARK

The Civic Center Next 100 project celebrates Denver’s First National Historic Landmark and aims to reinvigorate Civic Center Park for the Next 100 years by introducing thoughtful, contemporary updates that will create a premier destination for civic gatherings, community events, cultural performances and daily use.

The reinvigorated Civic Center Park will reopen as a park that more fully supports both event and everyday use and downtown Denver's flourishing cultural life.

KEY UPDATES INCLUDE:

- A rehabilitated historic Greek Theater with upgraded seating, stage and canopy for contemporary productions and increased use.
- Improved accessibility and circulation through park pathways that better connect the park.
- A new plaza commemorating the Gang of 19 protest and the disability rights movement.
- Updated landscape design with new garden rooms, plantings, and plaza areas.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

During construction, fencing will be around many key areas of the park, however, limited portions will remain open and accessible.

Construction Start: November 2025

Anticipated Completion: Summer 2027
