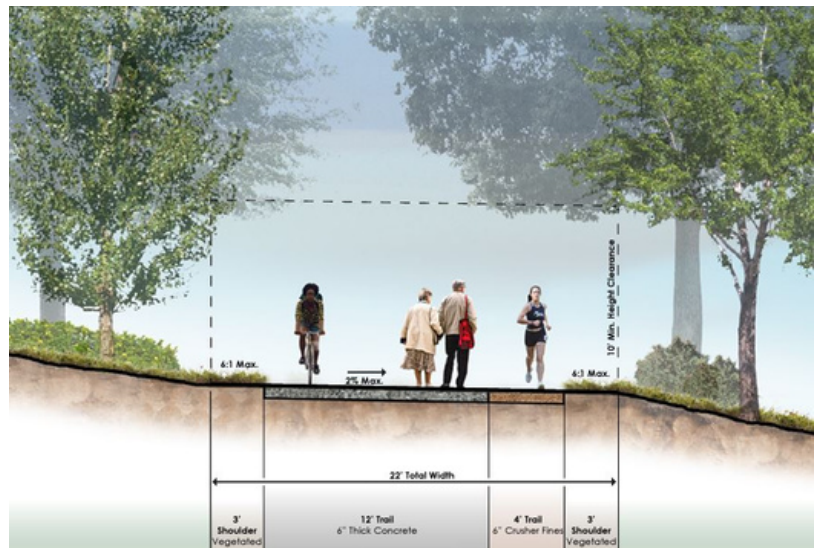

Brief project description

This project will construct a new segment of the Bear Creek Trail on the south side of Bear Creek through Bear Creek Park. The goal of this project is to minimize potential conflicts between regional trail users and general park users. The existing trail will remain through the park and the new trail will be designed to meet the regional trail standard of a 12' wide concrete trail and 4' wide crusher fines path. The project will also include the replacement of the trail crossing over the Marston drainage on the east side and a new 16' wide bicycle and pedestrian bridge on the west side of the park. Additional amenities include trail lighting, wayfinding, and rest areas.
