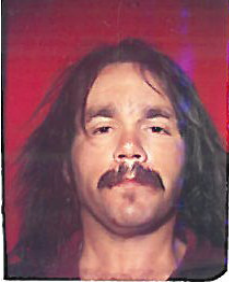




**“We Will Never Forget”**

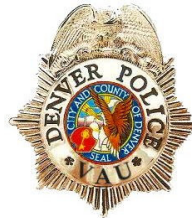

**Synopsis: On Sunday morning, June 29<sup>th</sup>, 1980 the victim was found lying on the bike path near 19<sup>th</sup> Street and Platte River Drive. The victim was suffering from a gunshot wound and died on July 9<sup>th</sup>, 1980 as a result of his injury. The victim was transient but had previously lived for a short time at the Raylene Apartments located at 30 E. 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue.**

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
