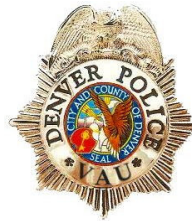

Upon arrival, officers found Savino Nuanes dead inside of the business; the victim of a robbery. Savino “Joe” Nuanes was the long time owner of Joe’s Liquor Store.
