Synopsis: On November 18th, 2006, officers responded to 3380 N. Monaco Pkwy on a report of a home invasion and shooting. The victim, Thomas Mack, was summonsed home by two other victims that were being held inside the house by three men with guns. Once Thomas arrived at the house, he was tortured by the suspects and then shot. The suspects then fled the scene. Thomas Mack died as a result of his injuries.

The Denver Police Department’s Cold Case Unit is seeking information that will lead to the arrest and prosecution of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.
