<p><b>Summary of Decision</b></p> <p>Jessica Brody recused herself from the hearing citing the conflict of interest created by her employer being the petitioner. On January 19, 2024, Jon Fischer, on behalf of Denver Water (“Petitioner”), filed a petition for variance (“Petition”) with the Board of Public Health and Environment (“Board”) requesting a variance from Chapter 36 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code governing noise control. The Department of Public Health and Environment (“Department”) responded with support for the Petition subject to certain conditions. The Board hereby finds that Petitioner has met its burden of proof pursuant to section 3.10 of the Rules and Regulations Governing Hearings Before the Board of Public Health and Environment, dated June 21, 2022, and, as such, grants the variance with the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Petitioner shall comply with all conditions set forth in the Department’s Recommendation dated January 31, 2024</li> </ul>
