On April 23, 2024, Denny’s Inc. (“Petitioner”) filed a petition (“Petition”) with the Board of Public Health and Environment (“Board”) requesting a variance from sections 1-2 and 3-603 (A) of the Rules & Regulations Governing Food Establishments. The Department of Public Health and Environment (“Department”) responded with support for the Petition subject to certain conditions. The Board hereby finds that Petitioner has met its burden of proof pursuant to section 3.10 of the Rules and Regulations Governing Hearings Before the Board of Public Health and Environment, dated June 21, 2022, and, as such, grants the variance with the following conditions:

- Petitioner shall comply with all conditions set forth in the Department’s Recommendation dated May 7, 2024, and
- Petitioner shall continuously monitor the Oregon potato dehydrated hashbrown to ensure the product achieves the required temperature parameters.
