Brief project description

The project will repair and reinforce a section of City Ditch, that runs through the southern half of Washington Park. Other improvements include: replacement of three pedestrian bridges, replacement of a short section of asphalt trail between the ditch and the lake with a crusher-fine surface, conversion to native plantings, and expansion and upgrades of the irrigation in this area of the park. In addition, the asphalt basketball court, which is no longer used, will be removed and replaced with turfgrass.
